Pre-Registration

By Mail: through October 13th
In Mexico at Bisbee's Tackle Store: through October 13th
In Mexico at Tournament Headquarters: up to noon on Oct. 15th
Tournament Headquarters opens in the host resort October 14th. Pre-registered teams must check in during on-site Registration to verify and complete information, sign up anglers, pick up team bags and attend the Captain's Meeting.

Early Bird Drawing

Entries received by July 31st are eligible for the Early Bird Drawing and a chance to win back your \$1,200.00 entry fee! The Early Bird Drawing takes place at the Awards Presentation.

Team Contact

The Team Contact is the designated team leader. Any instructions, confirmations or requests for information are sent to this person. Team Contact information must be complete and include a cell or local phone number and email address.

Anglers

There is no limit to the number of anglers per team, but **you must sign up all anglers during Registration**. It does not matter on which day anglers fish. Captains and mates may also be anglers, but must be registered as Anglers. At a minimum, you must provide a First Name, Last Name, City and State for all team participants.

Team Bags

Teams receive merchandise and event tickets for four anglers. Additional tickets and merchandise may be purchased at the event, and after the event merchandise can be purchased on-line at the Bisbee's Sports Store at www.bisbees.com/store.

PAYMENT METHODS & DEADLINES

Fees may be paid by Check, Wire Transfer or Cash in US Dollars only:

- ▶ Checks must be received by October 7, 2009
- ▶ Wire transfer deposits must be verified by October 16, 2009
- ▶ Cash is accepted at any time and is the only form of payment accepted in Mexico. Because of that—FOR YOUR SAFETY—we strongly advise you to pay entry fees before you arrive in Mexico.

ENTRY LEVELS AND FEES

Tournament Entry — \$1,200

Includes entry into the Tournament Award (Top Teams), Top Dorado and Top Tuna Awards.

Optional Daily Categories

There are four optional daily categories. You may enter any or all of the daily categories, but if you enter you must enter for both days. The dailies are awarded to the team that catches the single heaviest qualifying black or blue marlin or the single heaviest qualifying dorado

or tuna of the day (Gamefish Daily). You must be entered in the category to win.

- › \$200 Daily Category-Billfish (\$400)
- › \$500 Daily Category-Billfish (\$1,000)
- › \$1,000 Daily Category-Billfish (\$2,000)
- › \$500 Gamefish Daily Category (\$1,000)

Across the Board Entry Fee: \$5,600

AWARDS & CASH DISTRIBUTION

Tournament Award (Top Teams)

Awarded to the top three teams based on the heaviest single black or blue marlin weighed.

Top Dorado

Awarded to the team that catches the heaviest dorado. If there is no winner in this category the prize money rolls to the Top Tuna.

Top Tuna

Awarded to the team that catches the heaviest tuna. If there is no winner in this category the prize money rolls to the Top Dorado.

If there are no qualifying Dorado or Tuna weighed, the prize money in these categories rolls to the Top Teams (billfish) category.

Optional Daily Categories

Awards are based on Optional Daily Category entry fees with an eighty-five percent return. The amount allocated to cash awards is split evenly between the three days of competition.

Billfish Jackpots

Of the amount allocated to billfish jackpot cash awards for any particular day, one hundred percent is awarded to the team that catches the heaviest qualifying black or blue marlin of the day that is also entered in the daily category.

For example: Team A is entered in the \$500 Daily Category only. Team B is entered in the Daily Categories across the board. Team A catches the heaviest fish of the day, Team B catches the second heaviest fish of the day. Team A would win all of the cash for that day in the \$500 Daily Category only. Team B would win all of the cash for that day in the \$200 and \$1,000 Daily Categories.

If there is no winner on a particular day the prize money for that day rolls to the following day, unless it is the last day of the tournament in which case it rolls backwards to the largest fish caught in the category.

Gamefish Jackpots

The Gamefish Daily is first split 50/50 between the two species. Then, of the amount allocated to the dorado cash awards for any particular day, one hundred percent is awarded to the team that catches the heaviest qualifying dorado of the day and, of the amount allocated to the tuna cash awards, one hundred percent is awarded to the team that catches the heaviest qualifying tuna of the day. You must be entered in the Gamefish Daily to win.

If there is no winner on a particular day the prize money for that day rolls to the following day, unless it is the last day of the tournament in which case it rolls backwards to the largest fish caught in the category.

If there are no qualifying fish caught of a particular species throughout the entire tournament, the money for that species rolls to the other species on a day by day basis.

For example, if a qualifying dorado is caught every day, but no qualifying tuna are caught at all, the day 1 tuna jackpot money rolls to the day 1 dorado and the day 2 tuna jackpot money rolls to the day 2 dorado.

OTHER TOURNAMENT AWARDS

Top Release Teams

Awarded to the top three teams that accumulate the most billfish release points. This is a trophy category—no cash is awarded.
