### FORM INSTRUCTIONS

**TIMES:** Hooked: Time billfish was Hooked

R | B | L = Time billfish was Released, Boated or Lost

**STATUS:** R = Released, T = Tagged, L = Lost, B = Boated (billfish do not need to be tagged for points)

**ELIGIBLE SPECIES:** Black Marlin, Blue Marlin, Striped Marlin, Sailfish, Spearfish

### REPORTING PROCEDURES

1. Use a separate Scorecard for each day; record the date at the top. Official time is GPS, recorded to the full minute.
2. When you hook a billfish, call Radio Control and report the Team Name, Angler, Species, & Grid. As soon as you release, boat or lose the billfish call again and verify the Species and Status. Billfish being fought at lines out must be reported to Radio Control prior to lines out.
3. If you caught a billfish you must turn in the Scorecard on the same day you caught the fish. If you did not catch billfish, you do not need to turn in a Scorecard.

4. The Team Captain must print their name and sign indicating they agree to the information as recorded.

#### Release Division

Teams entered in the Release Division must verify their catch by taking Digital Photos or Video of billfish as they are released. Photos and videos must show the billfish next to the boat and identify the billfish species. Videos must be continuous. Teams are expected to provide their own digital camera and make sure the date and time on the camera is correct. Refer to Tournament Rules for more information.
